Program Eligibility by Federal Poverty Level for 2021

The Census Bureau determines the federal poverty threshold according to household size for the entire United States each year. For a household of four, the 2017 threshold is \$24,600. According to the Census Bureau’s most recent Official Poverty Measure, California ranks 17th-highest, with a 15 percent poverty rate.

According to official federal poverty statistics, 12.8% of Californians lacked enough resources—about \$25,500 per year for a family of four—to meet basic needs in 2018. This represents a modest decline from 13.3% in 2017 and is slightly above the lowest recent rate of 12.4% (in 2007).

Are you living in poverty? The 2020 federal poverty level (FPL) for a single person residing in the 48 contiguous states or Washington, D.C. is \$12,760. In Alaska, the federal poverty level for a single person is \$15,950 and in Hawaii it is \$14,680.

The US Census Bureau determines the Federal Poverty Level each year. The poverty level is based on the size of the household and the ages of family members. To qualify for a subsidy from the government, families must purchase their coverage through Covered California, and have a gross income no more than 400% of the federal poverty level. To also qualify for cost sharing reductions, your family gross income must be more than 138% and less than 250% of the federal poverty level.
