If you owe taxes, the IRS offers several options where you can pay immediately or arrange to pay in installments: Electronic Funds Withdrawal. Pay using your bank account when you e-file your return. Direct Pay. Pay directly from a checking or savings account for free. Credit or debit cards. Pay your taxes by debit or credit card online, by phone, or with a mobile device.

Taxpayers can pay tax bills directly from a checking or savings account free with IRS Direct Pay. Taxpayers receive instant confirmation once they've made a payment. With Direct Pay, taxpayers can schedule payments up to 30 days in advance.

### Easy ways to pay taxes | Internal Revenue Service

Ideally, you should pay your entire tax balance at the time you submit Form 4868 based on what you think you owe. Otherwise, you're likely to accrue interest and penalties on any unpaid balance. Remit as much as you can if you don't have enough money on hand to pay the entire balance due.

### Why We Pay Taxes - HISTORY

Credit cards are only accepted as payment for current year individual income tax due on original Forms 500, 500EZ, 500ES, corporate income tax due on original Forms 600 and 602ES, and liabilities presented to taxpayers via Georgia Department of Revenue assessment notices. Credit cards are not accepted at this time for payments associated with extensions or amended returns.
